संक्षिप्त परिचय

श्री हरियाणा शेखावटी ब्रह्माचार्याश्रम, भिवानी की स्थापना विद्यामार्तण्ड, पं० सीताराम शास्त्री जी के करकमलों द्वारा सन् 1911 में की थी, तब से यह संस्था संस्कृत, संस्कृति एवं हिन्दी के पुनरूत्थान में निरन्तर रूप से कार्य कर रही है। यह संस्था न केवल हरियाणा में अपितु देश की अग्रणी संस्कृत-हिन्दी संस्थाओं में से एक है जो चौ.रणबीर सिंह विश्वविद्यालय जींद से सम्बन्धित है।

यह संस्था भिवानी शहर के मध्य में 6 एकड़ भूमि में स्थापित है। इसमें 60 कमरे, एक सुसज्जित सभागार, प्रयोगशालाएँ तथा एक विशाल पुस्तकालय है जिसमें ज्ञानार्जन के लिए विभिन्न विषयों की पुस्तकें, पाण्डुलिपियों तथा उच्च विद्वानों द्वारा रचित ग्रंथ उपलब्ध हैं। परिसर में एक सुन्दर बाग है जिसमें भिन्न-भिन्न प्रकार के फूल, पौधे व वृक्ष हैं। वैदिक रीति से बनी हुई एक यज्ञशाला है। इसी परिसर में अनेक देवी देवताओं के मन्दिरों के अतिरिक्त भगवान् परशुराम का विशाल मन्दिर भी है। इसमें धार्मिक व शैक्षिक संस्थान एक दूसरे से सटे हुए हैं, जिनमें बौद्धिक विकास व अन्तरात्मक शुद्धि होती रहती है। इसके अतिरिक्त स्वास्थ्य एवं क्रीडा क्षेत्र के लिए 2 एकड़ भूमि संस्था से संलग्न है। आश्रम संस्था शहर के कोलाहल तथा प्रदूषण भरे वातावरण से मुक्त है।

अध्यापक शिक्षा की गुणवत्ता में सुधार के लिए संस्था द्वारा 2008 में पं० सीताराम शास्त्री बी.एड.ट्रेनिंग कॉलेज की शुरुआत की गई। केवल 7 वर्षों में ही अपनी गुणवत्ता एवं उत्कृष्ट परिणामों के कारण महाविद्यालय ने अपनी एक अलग पहचान बनाई है।

हमारा यह बी.एड. शिक्षण संस्थान 7 वर्षों से लगातार आर्दश शिक्षक तैयार करने में निरन्तर लगा हुआ है। हमारा बी.एड. कॉलेज विभिन्न प्रकार की सुविधाओं से युक्त है। यहां विद्यार्थियों को पढ़ाने के लिए उत्कृष्ट सेवाएं व सुविधा सम्पन्न कक्षा कक्ष हैं। कॉलेज में एक विशाल हॉल है जिसमें समय-समय पर विभिन्न प्रकार के कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन होता है। जिनसे विद्यार्थियों की प्रतिभा को उभारने का पूरा मौका मिलता है।

इसके साथ - साथ हमारे कॉलेज में विभिन्न विषयों के कुशल वक्ताओं के व्याख्यान आदि का भी आयोजन होता है। जिनसे विद्यार्थियों को विषय को गहराई से समझने का मौका मिलता है तथा कॉलेज में विभिन्न विषयों से संबंधित Work Shop आयोजित की जाती है। इस कॉलेज में बच्चों के खेलने के लिए विशाल खेल मैदान की सुविधा उपलब्ध है जिसमें समय-समय पर विभिन्न खेल कूद प्रतियोगिताओं का आयोजन किया जाता रहा है। हमारे शिक्षकों के कुशल मार्गदर्शन में हमारे विद्यार्थियों का न केवल मासिक परीक्षाओं में बल्कि वार्षिक परीक्षाओं में भी अच्छा परिणाम रहा है।

Rule & Regulations:

सभी विद्यार्थियों को नियमित रूप से कॉलेज आना आवश्यक है।

1. विद्यार्थियों के लिए अनिवार्य है कि वे महाविद्यालय में अनुपस्थित होने से पूर्व अवकाश हेतु स्वीकृति पत्र प्राप्त कर लें। यदि विशेष कारणवश ऐसा न कर सके तो महाविद्यालय में पुनः उपस्थित होने के तीन दिन के भीतर उन्हें अवकाश की स्वीकृति लेनी चाहिए। उसके बाद स्वीकृति नहीं दी जाएगी।
2. एक सप्ताह तक का अवकाश ट्यूटर द्वारा प्रदान किया जा सकता है तथा दो सप्ताह के लिए अवकाश ट्यूटर की सिफारिश पर प्राचार्य द्वारा प्रदान किया जा सकता है।
3. परीक्षा के दिनों में अवकाश केवल विशेष परिस्थितियों में ही ट्यूटर की सिफारिश पर प्राचार्य द्वारा प्रदान किया जाता है।
4. अस्वस्थता की अवस्था में यदि किसी विद्यार्थी को दस दिन से अधिक अवकाश प्राप्त करना हो तो उसे अपने आवेदन पत्र के साथ समुचित योग्यता प्राप्त चिकित्सक द्वारा दिया गया प्रमाण-पत्र संगलन करना होगा।

पुस्तकालय (Library)

विद्यार्थियों के ज्ञानार्जन एवं शैक्षिक कार्यों में मदद के लिए पुस्तकालय की भी व्यवस्था है जिसमें B.Ed के पाठ्यक्रम से सम्बन्धित सभी विषयों पर पुस्तके उपलब्ध है। 3800 के करीब पुस्तकें हैं। 15 Newspapers, 8 Journals और 8 पत्रिकाएँ विभिन्न लेखकों की अच्छी-अच्छी पुस्तकें भी हैं। विद्यार्थी अपना पुस्तकालय कार्ड बनवाने के पश्चात् 14 दिन के लिए 9 पुस्तकें निकलवा सकते हैं। आवश्यकता होने पर 14 दिन पश्चात् उन्हें Reissue करवा सकते हैं।

छात्रावास (Hostel)

संस्था परिसर में एक सभी आधुनिक सुविधाओं से युक्त कन्या छात्रावास है। छात्रावास शुल्क 500/-प्रतिमाह की दर से अर्धवार्षिक रूप में 3000/- तथा 500/- (Security refundable) अतिरिक्त प्रतिभूति राशि प्रवेश के समय ली जायेगी छात्रावास में 50 सीटे हैं। First come first serve प्रावधान है।

Co-curricular Activities:-

विद्यार्थियों में अनुभव द्वारा ज्ञान प्राप्त करने के उद्देश्य से दैनिक पाठ्यक्रियाओं के अलावा कॉलेज द्वारा अनेक दर्शनीय स्थलों पर भ्रमण करवाने की व्यवस्था की जाती है। हर वर्ष कॉलेज द्वारा शैक्षिक भ्रमण के लिए ले जाया जाता है तथा विद्यार्थियों को अपनी प्रतिभा प्रदर्शन करने के लिए यूथ फेस्टिवल में भेजा जाता है। महाविद्यालय में विभिन्न कार्यक्रम एवं गतिविधियां विद्यार्थियों के व्यक्तित्व के चहुँमुखी विकास में सहायक है। महाविद्यालय अपने विद्यार्थियों को नृत्य,नाटक,संगीत,गायन, वाद - विवाद व खेलकूद(खो-खो,लंबी कूद,ऊँची कूद,रेस) इत्यादि प्रतियोगिताओं में बढ़चढ़ कर भाग लेने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करता है।

Placement Cell

यह प्रकोष्ठ विद्यार्थियों में करियर सम्बन्धी जागरूकता विकसित करने की दृष्टि से महत्वपूर्ण कार्य कर रहा है। इस प्रकोष्ठ के माध्यम से विद्यार्थियों को विभिन्न शिक्षण संस्थाओं में साक्षात्कार के लिए भेजा जाता है। इस प्रकोष्ठ में Extension Lecture के माध्यम से विद्यार्थियों को करियर सम्बन्धी जानकारी दी जाती है।

Scholarship

संस्था के प्रधान श्री शिव प्रकाश जी के मार्गदर्शन में हर वर्ष संस्कृत महाविद्यालय से बी.एड. कॉलेज में एडमिशन लेने वाले विद्यार्थियों को 5000 रू. तक छात्रवृत्ति दी जाती है,इसके अलावा आर्थिक रूप से कमजोर विद्यार्थियों को भी छात्रवृत्ति दी जाती है।

Extension Lecture

महाविद्यालय द्वारा शिक्षा में गुणवत्ता लाने तथा शिक्षण-विधियों में सुधार के लिए समय-समय पर Extension Lecture का आयोजन किया जाता है,जिससे विद्यार्थियों को अपने विषय पर सम्पूर्णता हासिल करने का मौका मिलता है।

Alumni Meet

यह प्रकोष्ठ महाविद्यालय के प्रांगण में एल्युमनी मीट सम्पन्न करता है, जिसमें गत सत्रों के विद्यार्थियों को आमंत्रित किया जाता है, इस दिन विद्यार्थियों व Peer Group के अन्तर्गत विभिन्न महाविद्यालय के प्राचार्य व प्रोफेसर अपने अनुभवों को साझा करते हैं।

Educational & Vocational Guidance Cell

यह प्रकोष्ठ विद्यार्थियों में करियर सम्बन्धी जागरूकता विकसित करने की दृष्टि से महत्वपूर्ण कार्य कर रहा है। इस प्रकोष्ठ में Extension Lecture के माध्यम से विद्यार्थियों को जानकारी दी जाती है।

Youth Red Cross

इसके अंतर्गत महाविद्यालय में विद्यार्थियों से सामाजिक कार्य सम्बन्धी गतिविधियां करवाई जाती है, जिसमें रक्तदान शिविर, प्राथमिक उपचार सम्बन्धी प्रशिक्षण, पौधे लगाओ, बेटा बचाओ- बेटा पढ़ाओ, राष्ट्रीय नेताओं की जयन्ती तथा सफाई अभियान प्रमुख हैं।

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO B.ED. TWO YEAR REGULAR COURSE

Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor Degree or in the Master's Degree or any other Qualification recognized as equivalent there are eligible for admission to the programme.

Note:

- (i) There shall be no rounding off of percentage of marks of the qualifying examination from 0.5% and above to next higher number for the determining eligibility i.e. 49.5% and above will not be rounded off to 50%.
- (ii) 47.5% marks for SC/ST candidates of Haryana State only.
- (iii) 47.5% marks for Blind /Persons with Disabilities and visually/Hearing Impaired candidates.
- (iv) In case a candidate has passed the Master Degree Examination also after Bachelor Degree, the higher percentage of marks obtained in either of the two will be taken into consideration while preparing the merit
- (v) Compartmental candidates will not be allowed admission in B.Ed. (Regular Course) in any case.
- (vi) Cut off date for eligibility will be the last date/time of online choice filling.
- (vii) One year PG diploma in any subject will not be considered equivalent to Master's Degree.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLEGES

1. Every College/Department shall constitute an Admission Committee to be appointed by the Principal/Chair person from amongst the teachers of College / Department.
2. Verification of the documents of the candidate will be done by the respective Admission Committee of College/Department at the time of reporting for admission, by comparing with the original certificates against which candidate has been allotted seat. Any entry or information filled/made by the candidate, if found to be false, shall entail automatic cancellation of admission.
3. The admission committee may ensure that the Candidate has deposited the fee as per his / her entitlement.
4. Online reporting should be done as and when candidate reports at institute and not on the last date of admission.
5. After successful admission of the candidate, the institute must issue system generated provisional admission slip/ auto up-gradation letter to candidate.
6. Colleges are required to update admission status online on <http://www.hrybed.net>, <http://www.hrybed.in> in strictly as per admission schedule so that the subsequent counseling maybe conducted as per schedule, failing which they will be fined heavily.
7. All admissions by colleges are to be updated/ reported online, as and when they admit the candidates. No permission of any kind would be provided for admitting students, if status of admission not reported online as per Key dates/schedule.
8. Information about only those candidates, whose admission status has seen reported online, will be forwarded to Registration Branch of University
9. Responsibility for any wrong/irregular/excess admission will entirely rest upon the Principal/ Chairperson concerned.
10. Admission of candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from other university shall be provisional subject to verification of the eligibility by the Registration Branch of the university concerned.
11. All the rules and regulations for submission of Registration Return of students by the college will be applicable as per the rules of the concerned University.
12. Every College/Department must give accurate information on its web site regarding human and infrastructure resources along with subjects in which teachers are available in the College/Department.
13. Under no circumstances the original certificates of the candidate should be retained by the college. The candidate seeking admission will submit two sets of his/ her documents/ certificates duly self attested by Candidate, at the time of reporting in the college. The Principal of the college will authenticate these documents/ certificates after comparing these from the originals and the originals will be returned to the candidate. One set of these documents/ certificates thus authenticated by the college shall be deposited in the affiliating University, for the purpose of registration, for which no original certificate shall be demanded. Anyhow, if the affiliating University, so desires the original certificates from the candidate can be demanded through the institute of his/ her admission for any purpose what so ever these may be.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS AT A GLANCE

1. Prospectus containing eligibility conditions, list of participating institutions with no. of sanctioned seats, code no. of Colleges/Institutes and reservation policy can be seen/downloaded from University website www.crsu.ac.in or <http://www.hrybed.in>, <http://www.hrybed.net>.
2. Before filling the online Application Form the candidates are required to read the prospectus carefully. For any query, please contact the ten help line telephone numbers for the applicants and for the colleges the same will be mentioned here after receiving from the concerned agency.
3. The Admission to B.Ed. (Regular) Course for the session 2016-17 will be made on the basis of inter-semester percentage of the Qualifying Examination through online counselling by C.R.S.U. Jind.
4. In case a candidate has passed the Master Degree Examination also after Bachelor Degree, the higher percentage of marks obtained either in Under Graduate or Post Graduate degree of the two will be taken into consideration while preparing the merit.
5. No one who is already in employment (whole time or part time or in honorary capacity) shall be admitted to the B.Ed. (Regular) Course in any College of Education without taking leave from the employer for full academic session.
6. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility for admission before applying for the course. If on verification at a later stage, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be cancelled and the fee deposited by him/her shall be forfeited.
7. On-line registration-cum-counselling fee is Rs. 1000/- (Rs. 500/- registration fee plus Rs. 500/- Counseling fee) for General Category candidates and Rs. 625/- (Rs. 125/- registration fee plus Rs. 500/- Counseling fee) for SC/BC/PH candidates of Haryana state. Registration cum Counselling fee is non-refundable.
8. **On-line registration-cum-Counselling fee shall be deposited by the candidate through www.hbed2016.org, www.hbed2016.net in the Account of CRSU, Jind. Bank charges shall be paid by the candidate as given below: PNB AXIS Manual Challan Rs. 6/- Rs. 6/-**
9. All the candidates must verify their personal information during online registration.
10. **Locking of submitted choices is advisable, however, candidates who do not lock the choices, their last filled choice would be considered final.**
11. Registered candidates who do not fill choices or fail to save the same cannot be considered for admission and seat allotment.
12. Candidates must take print-out of their online Application Form along with their locked choices. This print-out has to be signed and submitted at the time of reporting for admission.

13. The outcome of different rounds will be displayed on the websites <http://www.hrybed.net>, <http://www.hrybed.in> as per admission schedule. No individual allotment letter will be sent to the candidates.
14. **All the candidates who are allotted seats will report to allotted college/institute within stipulated date, failing which their seat allotment shall stand cancelled. Also, they will not be considered for further Counsellings.**
15. Candidates will produce all the relevant certificates in original including registration-cum- counselling fee receipt for verification along with provisional allotment letter, a signed print out of their online application form, their locked choices generated from the website at the time of reporting.
16. At the time of reporting, if documents are found to be correct on verification then provisional admission/ auto up-gradation letter generated online will be issued to the candidate by the concerned college. The candidate shall check all the entries in this provisional admission/ auto up-gradation letter and should sign it and preserve it for further reference.
17. The allotment of seats is liable to be cancelled, if the personal data viz. Category, Sub-category, Group (Group-I Science & Arts with Maths, Group-II Arts & Commerce) residential status (Bonafide Residents of Haryana or All India Category), percentage of marks in qualifying examination, gender etc. submitted by the candidates at the time of registration is found to be wrong at the time of verification of the original certificates at Allotted Institutes. But, if the candidate is found to be eligible after the correction in personal data, the candidate may be considered for subsequent rounds of counseling, if any, against the vacancies only.
18. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of the information submitted by him/ her, which is found to be incorrect or false at any stage then his/ her admission shall be cancelled and all fees and other dues paid by him/ her shall be forfeited. The University/ College/ Institute may take further action, as deemed fit, against the candidate in accordance with law.
19. Candidate seeking admission in self financing institutions are advised to ensure that they are law fully admitted failing which, they shall not be authenticated by the CRSU. Jind and shall not be registered by the affiliating University and they themselves shall be responsible for any such lapse.
20. All the rules and regulations for the submission of migration certificates by the candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from other Universities will be applicable as per the rules of the University.
21. In case a candidate after having deposited required fee for admission to B.Ed (Regular) course 2016-17 decides to leave the B.Ed course before the last round of counselling, the fee deposited by the candidate will be refundable to him/her by the concerned college if the seat so vacated is filled by some other candidate after deducting Rs. 1000/- only.

22. In case of ambiguity about any rule, the interpretation of the same by the University shall be final.
23. All legal disputes relating to admission to B.Ed. (Regular) Course will be subject to Courts having jurisdiction at Jind.
24. The number of colleges/sanctioned seats may increase or decrease based upon the approval and affiliation from the University.
25. Candidates are advised to consult the updated list of colleges on the websites <http://www.hrybed.in>, <http://www.hrybed.net> before filling their choices as in take in various institutes subject to change by the competent authority in view of pending writs/appeals in courts/ NCTE with regard to their recognition.
26. The attendance rules of the affiliating university will be applicable on the students.
27. The participating colleges/Institutions/Universities will ensure that all the admissions will be made only on the basis of the recognized and valid degree (s)/certificate (s) issued by the approved and recognized boards/Institutes/Universities. In case any clarification of equivalence/recognition of qualifying degree / certificate/Institute/Board/University is required, the same may be obtained from the affiliating university.
28. All the updated latest information/notices/changes/ modifications will be displayed on the website. The candidates are required to visit the website regularly to obtain the latest information.

Under the broad curricular area, Engagement with the field, 20 weeks (4+16) shall be allocated over the two years for Tasks, assignments, Teaching Practice and school internship.

Distribution of Four Weeks

- ❖ During the First year, to support better understanding of schools and in preparation of Internship, teacher education institutes shall make provisions for visits to innovation centres of pedagogy and learning-innovative schools, educational resource centres, etc.
- ❖ Two weeks of First Year will be devoted to field engagement through different tasks and projects with the community, the school, and the child in out-of-school.
- ❖ Two weeks of Second year will be devoted to field engagement through different tasks and projects with the community, the school and the child in school and out of school along with the teaching practice for Pedagogy of School Subject I&II.

Distribution of Sixteen Weeks (School Internship)

- ❖ During the Internship, a student-teacher shall work as a regular teacher and participate in all the school activities, including planning, teaching and assessment, interacting with school teachers, community members and children.
- ❖ Initially, the student-teachers will observe the school and its classroom with a regular teacher for one week.
- ❖ For each Student-Teacher, Internship should be conducted preferably in one school within the District of concerned College of Education for the entire 16 weeks. However, this period can be divided into two blocks in such a way that teaching in one school at a particular Level (for example elementary or senior secondary) during one block is followed by the teaching in another school or the same school at another level during the second block. Under any circumstances, the student-teacher should not be sent to more than two schools during her/his internship period.
- ❖ Student-teachers should be provided opportunities to teach in government and private schools with systematic supervisory support and feedback from Principal/faculty of the school and concerned College of Education giving preference to practice school and limiting to concerned District only. After completing School Internship from the school, the principal of the concerned College of Education will countersign the certificate signed by Teacher Educator of concerned College and Principal of the School.

Note:- Internship should not be reduce to the delivery of a certain number of Lesson plans, but should aim for meaningful and holistic engagment with learners and the school. Moreover, teaching should not be practiced through the reductionist approach of 'micro teaching' of isolated 'skills' and simulated lessons.

Note-

1. Each Student will attend supervised teaching for two weeks in 2nd year.
2. Practical Exam for Course VI(A),VI(B),VII(A),& VII (B) will be conducted by the external examiners at the end of 1st year.
3. Examination of Skill in Teaching and School Based Activites will be conducted by an External Team consisting of one coordibator (Head Examiner should be of the parent Universty) and two Members (Sub-Examiners duly approved by the Board of studies) at the end of 4th Semester. While constituting the team,teaching subject of the Coordinator will be taken into consideration and it will not overleap with the Teaching subjects of other two examiners.Thus,a team will cover all the three streams i.e. Teaching of languages.Teaching of Sciences and Teaching of Social Sciences.

Criteria for the award of 20% Internal Assessment in Theory Papers will be as per the distribution given below :-

1.	One Task & Assignment in every theory paper	10% marks
2.	One test in every theory paper	5% marks
3.	Attendance	5% marks

NOTE-

If a candidate is awarded Internal Assessment of more than 75 %, the concerend teacher will give specific justification for the same which shall be considered to be constituted by the concerned principal of the College as the case may be.

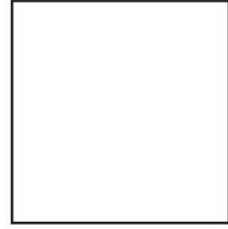
